“Account”	A password-protected personalised login to the Site providing Content specific to you.
“Back Marker”	A designated member of the Walking Group who walks at the back of the group ensuring nobody is left behind or take a wrong turn. Back Markers may have maps, whistles or a radio to help them with this task.
“Base”	The hostel, camp site or other dwelling where Members are residing during a Residential Event.
“Content”	Any information on the Site including without limitation text, photographs or other images.
“Event”	A recognised and formal OutdoorLads Event (such as a walk).
“Full Member”	A Member who has made a payment OutdoorLads for membership and is eligible to attend Events.
“Guest Member”	A Member who has not yet made a payment to OutdoorLads for membership and has attended two Trial Events; or a Full Member whose period of membership has expired.
“Home Contact”	A Member who is not participating in an Event but remains at home to provide support during an emergency.
“Leader”	A Member who is identified as taking overall responsibility for an Event or Residential Event. Some Events may have two or more Leaders on them.
“Leader Level”	The level that has been assigned to a Leader based on his level of experience or qualifications.
“Member”	An individual who has officially joined OutdoorLads, either as a Trial Member, Guest Member, or Full Member, and whose membership is still valid.
“Non-member”	An individual who has not officially joined OutdoorLads, or a former member whose membership is no longer valid.
“OutdoorLads”	The charity/outdoor pursuits organisation known as OutdoorLads and its Members.
“Residential Event”	A recognised and formal OutdoorLads Event where members stay for one or more nights in prearranged accommodation (for example, a hostel or a camp site).
“Trial Member”	A Member who has not yet made a payment to OutdoorLads for membership and has not yet attended two Trial Events.
“User”	Any person viewing or interacting with the Website.
“Walk Level”	The level that has been assigned to a particular walk based on estimated level of risk.

“Walking Group”	All Members (including the Leaders) who participate in a particular walking activity.
“We” or “Us”	OutdoorLads or any person or organisation involved in any part of the design, development, response-handling, marketing, promotion or other similar aspects of the Site;
“Website”	The Members’ website OutdoorLads.com and its content.
